FEDERAL FUNDING UPDATE

- HOUSE & SENATE HAVE PASSED THE CONTINUING RESOLUTION OMNIBUS AND THE PRESIDENT SHOULD SIGN THIS WEEK
- PROVIDES REMAINDER OF FEDERAL FY'S OBLIGATION AUTHORITY FOR HIGHWAYS, TRANSIT & SAFETY, AS WELL AS OTHER FEDERAL PROGRAMS
- AVERTED A GOVERNMENT SHUT-DOWN WHEN PREVIOUS CR EXPIRED DEC. 11TH

- WHILE IMPROVEMENTS IN NDOT'S STORMWATER MANAGEMENT PROGRAM WERE NOTED, THERE WERE TWO MAJOR VIOLATIONS OBSERVED
- THESE VIOLATIONS HAVE BEEN ADDRESSED

- MEETING WITH US EPA AND NDEP DECEMBER 16TH AND 17TH.




PROGRESS ON MAPPING

■ In Progress ■ % Mapped ■ % Mapped and Field Assessed




