TRANSPORTATION BILL STATUS REPORT

- SENATE EPW PASSED MAP-21 REAUTHORIZATION ACT
- \$265 BILLION FOR HIGHWAYS OVER 6 YEARS
 - NEW FREIGHT PROGRAM FUNDED AT \$6B OVER 6 YEARS
 - SENATE FINANCE HAS NOT IDENTIFIED HOW TO ADDRESS THE SHORTFALL; \$18 BILLION IN FFY 15
 - RESEARCH FUNDING CUT FROM \$400 M/YR. TO \$250 M/YR.



TRANSPORTATION BILL STATUS REPORT

- SPEAKER BOEHNER MEMO ISSUED MAY 30TH TO HOUSE REPUBLICANS
- PROPOSES 8 MONTH EXTENSION AT CURRENT FUNDING LEVELS
- FUNDED BY MODIFIED 6-DAY POSTAL DELIVERY AND TRANSFER FROM LEAKING UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK FUND



ORPHAN EARMARKS BILL

- WOULD RESCIND EARMARKS THAT HAVE 90% UNOBLIGATED FUNDS REMAINING
- EARMARKS DO NOT EXPIRE UNLESS CONGRESS PASSES A BILL TO RESCIND THEM
- DISCRETIONARY GRANTS EXPIRE AFTER THE YEAR AWARDED PLUS THREE YEARS (4 YRS.)
- INTERSTATE MAINTENANCE DISCRETIONARY AWARDS ARE AVAILABLE UNTIL FUNDS ARE OBLIGATED (THEY DO NOT EXPIRE)

- NDOT-TETRA TECH AMENDMENT FOR AIR MONITORING IN RTC PHASE 2
- AMENDMENT TO NDOT-RTC AGREEMENT IS UNDER DRAFT REVIEW
- VOLPE (FHWA) RECEIVED TETRA TECH'S PLAN AND PROVIDED COMMENTS. TETRA TECH RESPONDED.
- SURFACE SAMPLING STARTED LAST WEEK
- SUBSURFACE SAMPLING STARTS THIS WEEK



NDOT PROJECT UPDATES

- SR 207 KINGSBURY GRADE PROJECT FULL CLOSURE ENDED MAY 23, 2014. NIGHT WORK CONTINUES
- RECENTLY RECEIVED A NO-COST, FULL CLOSURE PROPOSAL FROM GRANITE CONSTRUCTION FOR A SECTION OF THE SR 431 MT. ROSE HIGHWAY REPAVING PROJECT.
 - PROPOSES WEEKLY PAVING OPS SUNDAY 7 P.M. THRU FRIDAY NOON, MT. ROSE SUMMIT TO DOUGLAS FIR DRIVE.
 - BEGIN AUGUST 11, 2014, ABOUT 3 WEEKS OF FULL CLOSURE
 - COMPLETE ENTIRE PROJECT BY END OF SEPTEMBER 2014
 - REDUCES WORKING DAYS FROM 180 TO 90
 - PILOT CAR FOR EMERGENCY VEHICLES, SUNRIDGE RESIDENTS, WASHOE CO. MAINTENANCE, SERVICE PROVIDERS, SCHOOL BUSES



US 95 NW PROJECT

- MAY 14TH PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING FOR PHASE 3A (TWO RAMPS FOR 215 BELTWAY/US 95 INTERCHANGE)
 - PHASE 3 WAS APPROVED IN NDOT'S FY 12 PLAN
 - EARLIER THIS YEAR, NDOT REQUESTED RTC TIP AMENDMENT TO FY 15 FOR PHASE 3A CONSTRUCTION (ITEM 7 OF TODAY'S AGENDA)
 - \$525 MILLION PROJECT REFERENCED IN MEDIA REPORT IS FOR ALL PHASES (2029 COMPLETION)
