# FEDERAL UPDATE

## POSSIBLE RESCISSION OF FUNDS

- SENATE FFY 17 APPROPRIATIONS BILL FOR TRANSPORTATION, HOUSING & URBAN DEVELOPMENT (THUD APPROPRIATIONS) WOULD RESCIND SOME OF THE CONTRACT AUTHORITY GRANTED TO THE STATE DOTs
- TOTAL AMOUNT NATIONALLY IS \$2.2 BILLION IN FFY 17; COULD RESULT IN \$19M LESS TO NDOT IN FFY 17
- HOUSE APPROPRIATIONS BILL HAS NO RESCISSION; BUDGET ISSUE TO BE RECONCILED WITH SENATE
- AASHTO, NATIONAL GOVERNORS ASSOCIATION AND NATIONAL CONFERENCE OF STATE LEGISLATURES WROTE A LETTER OF CONCERN TO CONGRESS



TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM



- \$8.7M AVAILABLE, \$750k MAX PER PROJECT
- IMPROVE NON-MOTORIZED MOBILITY, HISTORIC PRESERVATION FOR TRANSPORTATION-RELATED PROJECTS, SCENIC ACCESSIBILITY, SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL AND MORE
- INFRASTRUCTURE AND NON-INFRASTRUCTURE
- APPLICATIONS DUE BY JULY 8<sup>TH</sup>



# AASHTO SPRING MEETING AUTONOMOUS & CONNECTED VEHICLES ROUNDTABLE

- AASHTO (NATIONAL ORGANIZATION OF STATE DOTs) AND AAMVA (NATIONAL ORGANIZATION OF STATE DMVs) COLLABORATED ON A ROUNDTABLE DISCUSSION ON AUTONOMOUS AND CONNECTED VEHICLES
- NEVADA DOT AND NEVADA DMV JOINED OUR MICHIGAN AND CALIFORNIA COUNTERPARTS TO DISCUSS AV REGULATIONS, ONGOING TESTING AND INFRASTRUCTURE CONSIDERATIONS
- NDOT AND DMV WILL CONTINUE TO BE ENGAGED IN THE NATIONAL DIALOGUE ON AVs



# TRANSPORTATION ASSET MANAGEMENT PLAN

- THE ASSET MANAGEMENT PLAN (TAMP) HAS BEEN DRAFTED
- ENTERPRISE ASSET MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (EAMS) TO BE DEVELOPED
- EAMS WILL REPLACE AND CONSOLIDATE OUTDATED, INDEPENDENT SYSTEMS (MTC. MGT., EQUIPMENT, PAVEMENT MGT.)
- RFI ISSUED IN APRIL; 9 RESPONSES; 4 DEMONSTRATIONS
- RFP TO BE ISSUED MID-JUNE 2016
- TRANSPORTATION BOARD WILL BE ASKED TO CONSIDER APPROVAL OF THE CONTRACT FOR EAMS DEVELOPMENT


