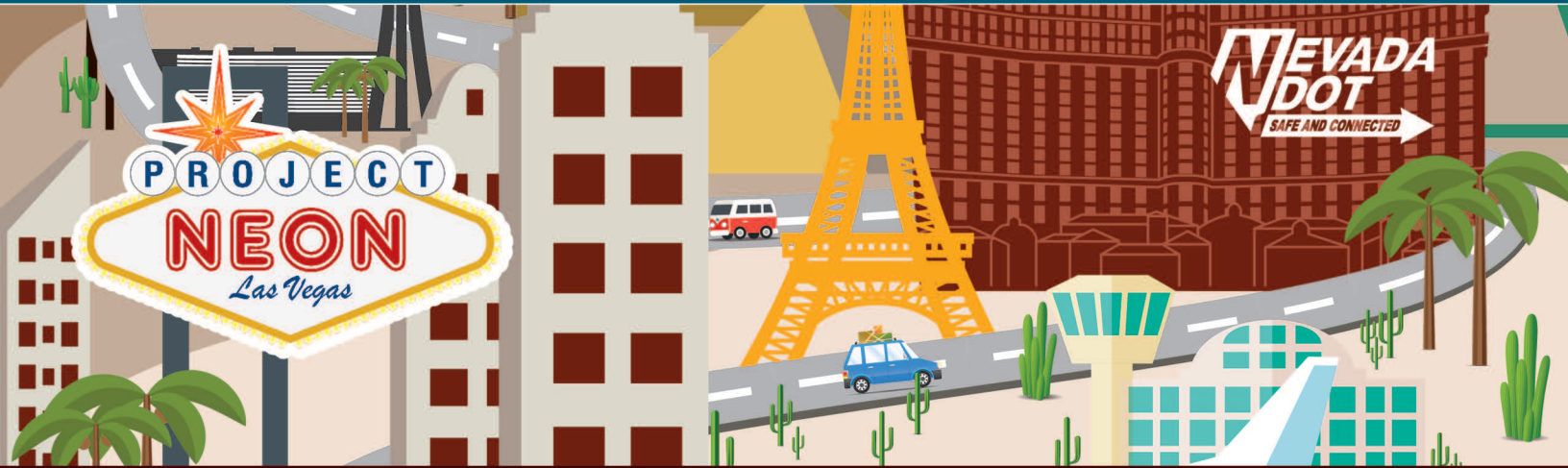

NDOT invites you to attend a public meeting for Project Neon. Construction of the project, which is improving 3.7 miles of I-15 between Sahara Avenue and the Spaghetti Bowl, is more than half-way complete. Join us to learn about progress to date, construction planned for 2018 and 2019, and associated traffic impacts.

You'll be able to take a virtual reality tour of the completed project, and learn more about the project's goals and planned improvements, the timelines for upcoming traffic changes and soundwall installations, and the schedule for the continued development of new downtown connections. You'll also have the opportunity to meet the project team, ask questions, and provide comments. *Free parking is available at the school and in the City parking garage to the west of the school.*

Join us to learn more about these and other project highlights:

- New High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) direct connect between U.S. 95 and I-15
- Conversion of express lanes on I-15 to HOV lane and general purpose lane
- New I-15 HOV interchange just south of Charleston Blvd ("Neon Gateway")
- I-15/Charleston Boulevard Interchange reconstruction
- Extension of Grand Central Parkway to Industrial Road
