



NEVADA BRIDGES ARE #1 FOR THE 5TH YEAR IN A ROW



- BASED ON ARTBA REPORT USING 2017 US DOT BRIDGE INVENTORY DATA
- ONLY 1.6% OF NEARLY 2,000 BRIDGES ARE "STRUCTURALLY DEFICIENT"
- THE NATIONAL AVERAGE IS 8.9% STRUCTURALLY DEFICIENT





FEDERAL UPDATE

- A BUDGET WAS SIGNED WHICH FUNDS THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT THROUGH FRIDAY, MARCH 23RD
- SETS THE STAGE FOR A 2-YEAR SPENDING BILL
 - BOOSTS FEDERAL SPENDING \$300B OVER THE NEXT TWO YEARS FOR DEFENSE AND NON-DEFENSE
 - SUSPENDS THE DEBT CEILING FOR ONE YEAR
 - SOME IN THE HOUSE HAVE FISCAL POLICY CONCERNS
- INFRASTRUCTURE PLAN DETAILS ISSUED TODAY AS THE TRUMP ADMINISTRATION RELEASES ITS BUDGET REQUEST TO CONGRESS





FEDERAL UPDATE

- BUILDING AMERICA'S INFRASTRUCTURE
 - \$200 BILLION TO SPUR \$1.5 TRILLION IN INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENTS
 - \$100 B INCENTIVES PROGRAM
 - \$20 B TRANSFORMATIVE PROJECTS PROGRAM
 - \$20 B EXPANDING INFRASTRUCTURE FINANCING PROGRAMS
 - \$50 B INVEST IN RURAL AMERICA PROGRAM
 - \$10 B FEDERAL CAPITAL REVOLVING FUND
 - INFRASTRUCTURE INCLUDES SURFACE TRANSPORTATION, PORTS, AIRPORTS, PASSENGER RAIL, WATER, FLOOD CONTROL, POWER, BROADBAND, AND BROWNFIELDS
 - INCREASE STATE AND LOCAL AUTHORITY ON ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW AND PERMITTING
 - ALLOW FEDERAL AGENCIES TO DIVEST FEDERAL ASSETS TO STATE, LOCAL GOVERNMENT OR PRIVATE SECTOR
 - ELIMINATE REGULATORY BARRIERS, STREAMLINE PERMITTING
 - WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

- LT. GOVERNOR HUTCHESON, MARTIN-HARRIS CONSTRUCTION AND NDOT ATTENDED IN SUPPORT








HORSE ISSUES ON US 50

- MULTIPLE COLLISIONS INVOLVING WILD OR FERAL HORSES HAVE OCCURRED ON US 50
- NDOT AND 7 OTHER STATES AND ONTARIO MINISTRY OF TRANSPORTATION ARE JOINTLY CONDUCTING A POOLED FUND STUDY OF THE EFFECTIVENESS OF WILDLIFE CROSSINGS (UNDERPASSES OR OVERPASSES) FOR VARIOUS SPECIES TO REDUCE COLLISIONS AND MAINTAIN HABITAT CONNECTIVITY
- NDOT IS CONDUCTING A RESEARCH PROJECT ON WHERE TO CONSIDER WILDLIFE CROSSINGS IN OUR STATE




VIRGINIA RANGE, 2010-14

HORSE ISSUES ON US 50

- CHALLENGES IN AREAS WHERE COLLISIONS ARE STILL OCCURRING
 - HORSES GO WHERE FOOD AND WATER ARE AVAILABLE, WHICH IS OFTEN THE DEVELOPED AREAS ALONG US 50
 - PRIVATE PROPERTY, TERRAIN, AND CURRENT LAND USE AFFECTS WHERE FENCING OR WILDLIFE CROSSINGS CAN BE PLACED EFFECTIVELY
 - THERE ARE MANY UNCONTROLLED CROSSINGS (STREETS, PRIVATE DRIVEWAYS) WHERE HORSES CAN GET INTO THE US 50 RIGHT-OF-WAY
 - HORSES HAVE TRIED TO CROSS AT CATTLE GUARDS AND HAVE GOTTEN STUCK
 - EXISTING FENCE HAS BEEN CUT BY OFF-ROADERS AND GATE LOCKS HAVE BEEN CUT; IT REQUIRES CONSTANT MAINTENANCE
 - PLACING STREET LIGHTING ALONG THE LENGTH OF US 50 WOULD BE COSTLY. MUCH OF THE AREA IS SPARSELY DEVELOPED





HORSE ISSUES ON US 50

FUTURE ACTIONS

- MEET WITH FIRST RESPONDERS (NHP, LYON COUNTY SHERIFF, NV DEPT. OF AGRICULTURE, ETC.) TO DISCUSS RESPONSE PROCEDURES AND KEEP STAKEHOLDERS INFORMED OF WHAT NDOT IS DOING TO ADDRESS THIS ISSUE
- INVENTORY GAPS IN FENCING AND UNCONTROLLED CROSSINGS WHERE HORSES CAN GET INTO THE US 50 RIGHT-OF-WAY AT MOUND HOUSE, DAYTON AND STAGECOACH
- DEVELOP A MITIGATION PLAN; DETERMINE WHAT APPROVALS
 ARE REQUIRED (ENVIRONMENTAL, RIGHT-OF-WAY, FEDERAL,
 ETC.); DEFINE OPTIONS AVAILABLE (INFRASTRUCTURE, NON-INFRASTRUCTURE) AND COST ESTIMATES
- PROVIDE A COMPREHENSIVE PRESENTATION TO THE TRANSPORTATION BOARD AT A LATER DATE

- \$2 MILLION ROUNDABOUT PROJECT AT SR 88 AND CENTERVILLE LANE ADVERTISES FOR BIDS THIS MONTH
- US 50 & PIKE ST. IN DAYTON; US 50 & SILVER STATE ST. IN CARSON CITY PED SAFETY PROJECTS ADVERTISED FOR BIDS
- \$1.8 MILLION ELECTRIC AVE. TRAFFIC SIGNAL AT USA PARKWAY AWARDED TO SNC

Engineering

- Preliminary Alternatives are being revised based on public comment and design workshops
- Traffic and Safety Analysis will be complete in Feb.
- Risk Based Estimates complete for each alternative complete in Feb.



NEPA

- Cultural Resource Surveys and Reports are nearly complete
- Air Quality and Noise Analysis are underway
- Visual Effects exhibits are under development
- Environmental Justice surveys have been completed
- Hazardous Materials surveys are complete
- Several sections of the DEIS are under development
- Section 4(f) evaluation underway

Public Outreach


- Two sets of public meetings have been held, plus a Reno-Sparks Indian Colony community meeting
- 93 individual stakeholder meetings have been done to date
- The website and hotline are active
- The DEIS Public Hearing is currently scheduled for early 2019.
- Individual stakeholder outreach will continue throughout 2018

- WIDENS 6 MILES OF US 95
- PROVIDES A DIVERGING DIAMOND INTERCHANGE AT KYLE CANYON RD. (ACCESS TO MT. CHARLESTON)
- PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING ON FEBRUARY 21ST TO PRESENT ANTICIPATED CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS

- OPEN CONFIDENTIAL PRICE INFORMATION THIS WEEK
- COMBINE TECHNICAL & PRICE FOR COMBINED SCORE THEN MAKE A RECOMMENDATION TO TRANSPORTATION BOARD NEXT MONTH
- COORDINATE WITH GOVERNOR'S FINANCE OFFICE AND SUBMIT A REQUEST FOR INTERIM FINANCE COMMITTEE APPROVAL TO ADD TO NDOT'S CURRENT BIENNIAL BUDGET





RECENT SETTLEMENTS & VERDICTS

- SETTLEMENT WITH I-15 & CACTUS LLC APPROVED AT JANUARY 9TH BOE
 - \$815K (\$65K ADDITIONAL FROM AMOUNT PREVIOUSLY DEPOSITED WITH COURT
 - PROPERTY FOR CACTUS INTERCHANGE AT I-15
- SETTLEMENT WITH TOMAHAWK, LLC FOR PARCEL AT I-15 STARR AVE. INTERCHANGE EXPECTED AT MARCH BOE
