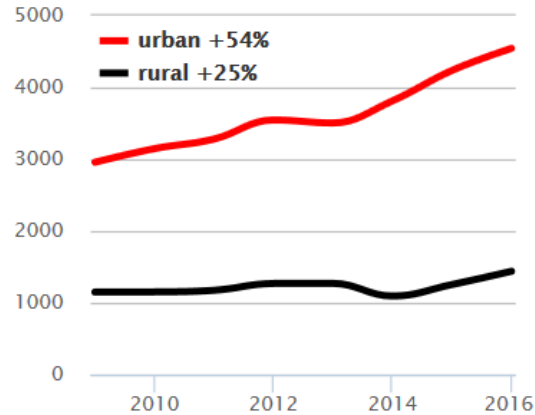

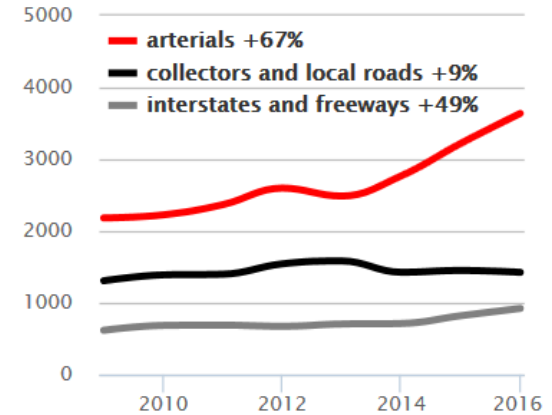
PEDESTRIAN FATALITIES ON THE RISE NATIONALLY

- PED FATALS INCREASED 46% BETWEEN 2009 AND 2016
- NEARLY 6,000 PEDESTRIANS KILLED ON OR ALONG U.S. ROADS IN 2016
- REPORT ISSUED BY INSURANCE INSTITUTE FOR HIGHWAY SAFETY

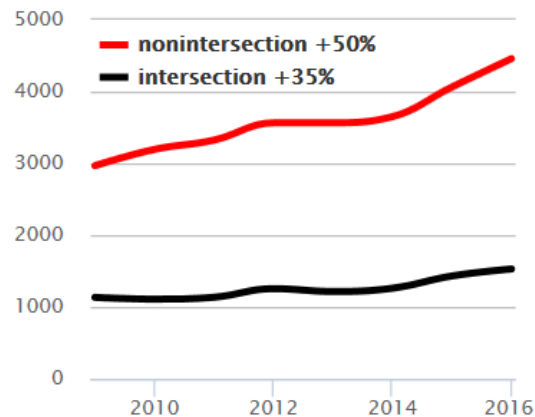
By land use



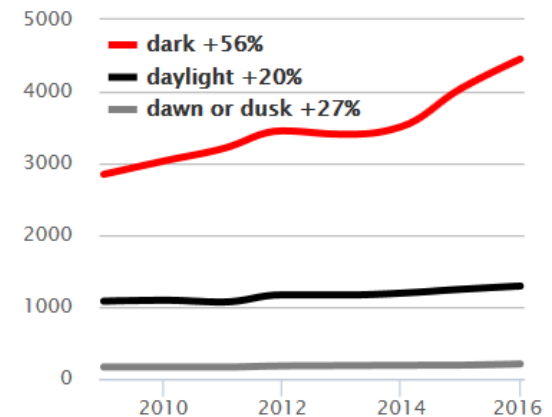
By road type

FEDERAL UPDATE

- BUILD ACT NOTICE OF FUNDING OPPORTUNITY ISSUED APRIL 24TH 2018, DUE JULY 19TH
 - \$1.5 BILLION AVAILABLE
 - REPLACES TIGER
 - PROJECTS WILL BE AWARDED BASED ON MERIT CRITERIA: SAFETY, ECONOMIC COMPETITIVENESS, QUALITY OF LIFE, ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION, STATE OF GOOD REPAIR, INNOVATION, PARTNERSHIP, AND ADDITIONAL NON-FEDERAL REVENUE FOR FUTURE TRANSPORTATION INVESTMENTS
 - USDOT INTENDS TO AWARD A GREATER SHARE OF GRANTS TO PROJECTS LOCATED IN URBAN AREAS, INCLUDING SUPPORT FOR RURAL BROADBAND DEPLOYMENT WHERE IT IS PART OF AN ELIGIBLE TRANSPORTATION PROJECT



FEDERAL UPDATE

- RENO CHOSEN AS A DRONE TESTING SITE BY USDOT, 1 OF 10 SELECTED (149 APPLICATIONS)
- HEIDI KING PICKED TO LEAD NHTSA, WILL HAVE A HEARING BEFORE THE SENATE COMMERCE COMMITTEE THIS WEEK BEFORE
- TRUMP ADMINISTRATION PROPOSED A \$15 BILLION RESCISSION (BROAD, NOT LIMITED TO TRANSPORTATION). TRANSPORTATION PORTION RELATED TO UNUSED EARMARKS



RENO AIRPORT RAMPS

- NDOT RECENTLY MET WITH RENO AIRPORT STAFF AND THEIR NEW CONSULTANT KITTELSON & ASSOCIATES
- WE'LL CONTINUE WORKING ON THE DRAFT EIS AND WE'RE COMMITTED TO KEEPING THE AIRPORT INFORMED
- MAY 9TH NDOT LETTER TO AIRPORT RESPONDS TO STATEMENTS MADE IN RECENT RGJ ARTICLE
 - RSB PROJECT TEAM HAD MET WITH AIRPORT STAFF SEVERAL TIMES SINCE MID-2017 TO THE PRESENT
 - RSB PROJECT TEAM OFFERED TO BRIEF AIRPORT BOARD BUT WAS TOLD NO BY AIRPORT STAFF
 - AIRPORT MISSTATED RSB PROJECT COST AT \$3 - \$5 BILLION (\$2 – \$2.5 BILLION IS MORE ACCURATE RANGE), AS WELL AS UNDERSTATING THE COST TO REPLACE THE RAMPS

- SPEED LIMIT REDUCED TO 45 MPH APPROACHING THE ROUNDABOUT



I-80 REPAVING AND US 395 REHAB PROJECTS STARTED

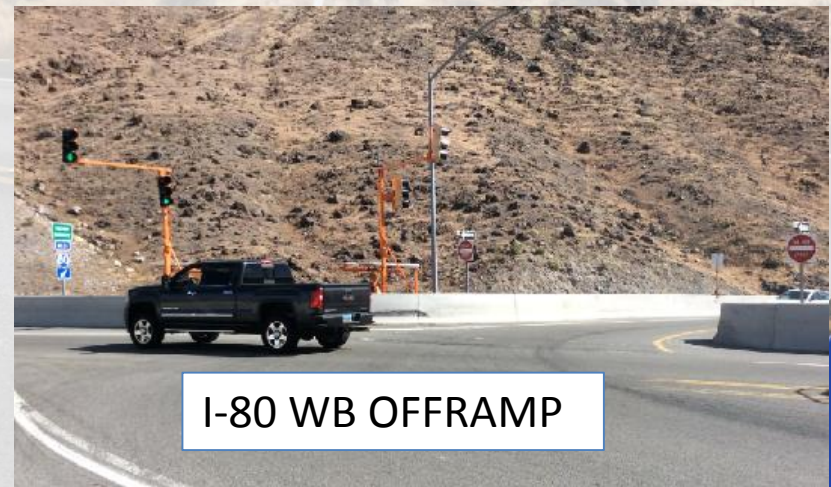
- NIGHT WORK COMMENCED SUNDAY NIGHT ON \$42.6 MILLION PROJECT FROM KEYSTONE AVE. TO CA/NV LINE
- STARTED CONCRETE SLAB REPLACEMENT PROJECT ON US 395, I-80 TO NORTH McCARRAN





USA PARKWAY ELECTRIC AVE. TRAFFIC SIGNAL UPDATE

- TEMPORARY SIGNALS PLACED NEAR THE I-80 INTERCHANGE AND AT WALTHAM WAY
- UTILITY RELOCATIONS AT ELECTRIC AVE. CONTINUE
- ACTIVATE PERMANENT SIGNAL BY MID-AUGUST 2018





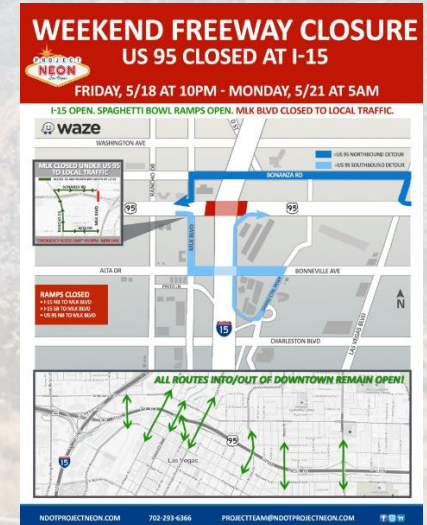
SOUTHERN NV PROJECTS

- RTC OF SOUTHERN NEVADA EXPECTS THEIR I-11 PHASE 2 PROJECT TO OPEN TO TRAFFIC IN LATE JULY 2018; COORDINATING EVENT WITH GOVERNOR'S OFFICE
- BLUE DIAMOND ROAD PHASE 2 WIDENING AND REPAVING BIDS OPENED LAST WEEK
 - 5 BIDDERS
 - APPARENT LOW BIDDER IS AGGREGATE INDUSTRIES, \$58.6 MILLION
 - ENGINEER'S ESTIMATE WAS IN THE \$59 – 71 MILLION RANGE



SOUTHERN NV PROJECTS

- PROJECT NEON “THE MAIN EVENT” CONTINUES
- FULL CLOSURE OF US 95 THIS WEEKEND FOR BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION
 - COORDINATED WITH ELECTRIC DAISY CARNIVAL DEVELOPER
- NEON \$140 MILLION BOND TO BE ISSUED TOMORROW
 - NDOT RETAINED OUR HIGH BOND RATINGS
 - LOTS OF INTEREST





ITEMS OF NOTE

- TRUCKEE MEADOWS WATER AUTHORITY TO PRESENT WATER RIGHTS MANAGEMENT TO THE TMWA BOARD ON MAY 23RD (INVOLVES NDOT)
- FORMAL RELINQUISHMENT OF ESCALATORS AT TROPICANA AND LAS VEGAS BOULEVARD TO CLARK COUNTY EXPECTED AT JUNE 2018 TRANSPORTATION BOARD MEETING.
