US 95/CC 215 CENTENNIAL BOWL PHASE 3C UPDATE

- BIDS OPENED JUNE 28TH ARE SIGNIFICANTLY ABOVE ENGINEER'S ESTIMATE (ABOUT 25% HIGHER)
 - ESTIMATE WAS AT THE LOWER END OF THE \$49 - \$59 MILLION RANGE ADVERTISED FOR BIDS
 - APPARENT LOW BID WAS APPROXIMATELY \$61M
 - CURRENTLY REVIEWING UNIT BID PRICES AND CHECKING PLAN QUANTITIES FOR ERRORS

- TONOPAH EVCS UPDATE
 - UNDERGROUND UTILITY TO BE RELOCATED
 - WORKING WITH VALLEY ELECTRIC ON FIBER RELOCATION
 - REDESIGNING RETAINING WALL
 - CONSIDERING RENEGOTIATION OF SOME BID ITEMS
 AND DO OUR BEST TO COMPLETE IN 2018
- RURAL EVCS WITHIN STATE HIGHWAY ROW
 - MEETING WITH GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF ENERGY AND GOE/NDOT DEPUTY AGS TO DISCUSS NRS RESTRICTIONS ON USE OF PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY





SOUTHERN NV PROJECTS

- RTC OF SOUTHERN NEVADA WILL HOLD GROUNDBREAKING EVENT FOR THEIR I-11 PHASE 2 PROJECT ON AUGUST 9TH
- BOARD WILL CONSIDER AWARDING BLUE DIAMOND ROAD PHASE 2
 WIDENING AND REPAVING BIDS AWARD TODAY
 - APPARENT LOW BIDDER IS AGGREGATE INDUSTRIES, \$58.6 MILLION
- ENVIRONMENTAL TEAM IS WORKING OUT THE TROPICANA INTERCHANGE NEPA CLEARANCE AND IMPACTS OF RELOCATING THE PLANNED HOV RAMP AT HACIENDA AVENUE
 - LIKELY UPDATE THE HOV PLAN FOR THIS AND ALSO INVESTIGATE AN HOV CONNECTOR AT CITY PARKWAY AND I-515 IN DOWNTOWN LAS VEGAS.
- FHWA FORMALLY REJECTED THE SLIP RAMP CONCEPT AT CITY PARKWAY
 AS IT DID NOT MEET CURRENT STANDARDS FOR INTERSTATE ACCESS.
 CHANGING THE RAMP FROM A GENERAL PURPOSE SLIP RAMP TO AN HOV
 RAMP COULD BE MORE ACCEPTABLE TO FHWA.
