## ABOUT THE PROJECT:

This project will restripe lanes along the I-515 and I-215 near the Henderson Spaghetti Bowl that will enhance mobility and safety. The ramp access from I-515 southbound to I-215 westbound is being moved to the Lake Mead Pkwy East ramp. Access to some ramps and locations will require the use of local streets after project is complete.

This meeting is being held in an open house format. Project representatives will give a brief presentation followed by a short question and answer period from the audience. Project representatives will be available to answer questions before and after the presentation. During this meeting, and through Friday, September 7, 2018, your comments are welcome regarding this project.








# PURPOSE & NEED • Significant growth in the area has increased traffic on the I-515 southbound to I-215 westbound ramp. • During peak hours, more than 50% of the I-515 southbound traffic is positioning in the right-hand lane to take the westbound I-215 exit. This causes significant queuing in the right lane, and conflicts with southbound Auto Show traffic weaving to southbound I-515. • A reduction in speed has also been observed in the I-215 weaving area between I-515 and the Gibson Rd. off-ramp.









# PROJECT DESCRIPTION NDOT has identified some improvements that can be made at the system to system interchange of I-515 and I-215 that will improve mobility and enhance safety. Our purpose today is to inform you of these upcoming traffic changes that will be implemented between September and November 2018.



# PROJECT DESCRIPTION


- · These current changes are considered interim improvements.
- The Department of Transportation is in the process of developing a larger long-term project, with the City of Henderson, to address additional concerns with the interchange.
- A feasibility study has already begun to identify needed improvements. Once the improvements are identified, the federal and environmental processes can begin.
- When these processes are completed, funding can be identified, and the future project can move towards construction.
- The expected timeline of this future project is 4 to 8 years.

# PROJECT DESCRIPTION

- To accommodate the additional lane on the ramp, and to alleviate the weaving issues, two existing traffic movements will be eliminated.
  - Traffic entering I-515 southbound from Auto Show Dr. will be able to continue south on I-515, but will not be able to move to I-215 westbound.
  - Traffic heading westbound on I-215 from Lake Mead Pkwy will no longer be able to merge over to the Gibson Rd. off ramp.











# PROJECT SCHEDULE

- Current construction schedule has the project starting early September and finishing early November.
- NDOT will send out public notifications regarding traffic impacts as construction comes closer.
- Construction operations will be restricted to non peak hours, and lane or ramp closures will be restricted to night time work only.
