US EPA CONSENT DECREE

- NDOT HAS MET OR EXCEEDED ALL DEADLINES FOR REQUIREMENTS CONTAINED IN THE CONSENT DECREE WITH THE US EPA
- NO STIPULATED PENALTIES WERE INCURRED
- IN JULY 2018, NDEP AND US EPA CONCURRED THAT NDOT MET ALL REQUIREMENTS AND APPROVED TERMINATION OF THE CD
- JUDGE SIGNED ORDER TERMINATING THE CONSENT DECREE ON SEPTEMBER 17TH





EMERGENCY OPERATIONS

- SR 164, NIPTON RD.; \$3.45 M CONTRACT WAS AWARDED LAST MONTH
- NIPTON ROAD WAS RE-OPENED TO TRAFFIC ON OCTOBER 2ND



- \$200K EMERGENCY REPAIR OF DAMAGED STORM DRAIN PIPES ON KIETZKE LANE AWARDED TO Q&D CONSTRUCTION



FEDERAL UPDATE

- MANY CONGRESSIONAL MEMBERS CONCENTRATING ON CAMPAIGNING FOR MID-TERM ELECTIONS
- FFY 19 APPROPRIATIONS BILL FOR TRANSPORTATION AND HOUSING IS EXPECTED BEFORE DECEMBER 7TH
- FIVE YEAR FAA REAUTHORIZATION BILL PASSED
- WORKING WITH NATIONAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON TOURISM AND TRAVEL INFRASTRUCTURE (NACTTI) TO IDENTIFY NEVADA PROJECTS THAT COULD SUPPORT TOURISM. (STEVE HILL FROM LVCVA IS ON THE COMMITTEE)



FEDERAL UPDATE

- NDOT HAS IDENTIFIED BRIDGES FOR FHWA COMPETITIVE HIGHWAY BRIDGE PROGRAM GRANT FOR RECONSTRUCTION AND REHABILITATION OF BRIDGES; \$225M NATIONAL PROGRAM WITH A FOCUS ON RURAL STATES
 - I-515 EASTERN & DESERT INN STRUCTURES
 - LOCKWOOD BRIDGES OVER UPRR AND OVER THE TRUCKEE RIVER
 - LOVELOCK BRIDGES (INCLUDES THE OLDEST BRIDGE IN THE STATE, BUILT IN 1919 ON NDOT CONTRACT NO. 0001)



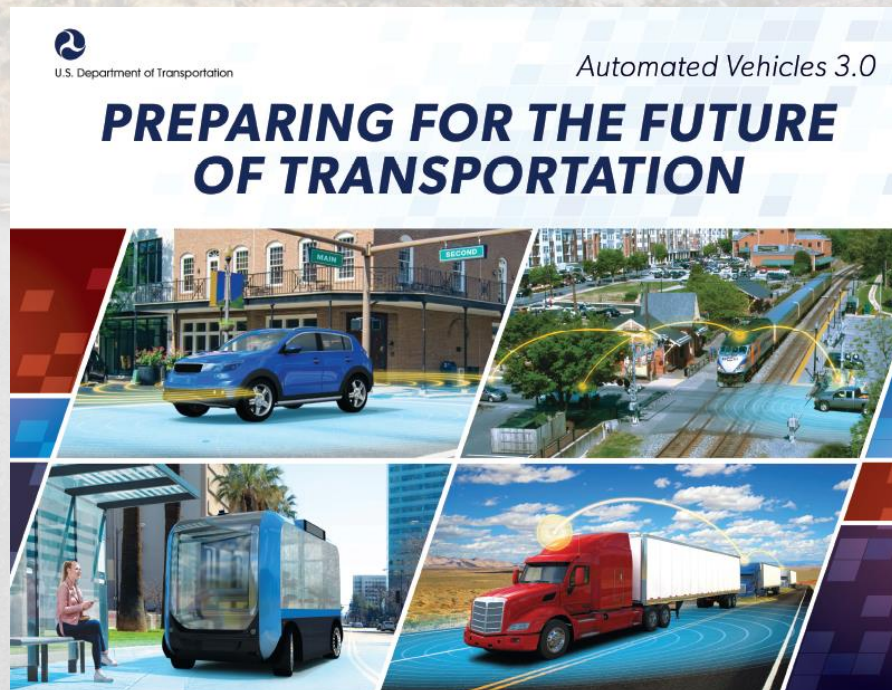
FEDERAL UPDATE

- DC COURT OF APPEALS AGREED TO DELAY UNTIL FEBRUARY 16, 2019, A CONTROVERSIAL AIR QUALITY DECISION IT MADE BACK IN FEBRUARY 2018
 - THE DC COURT OF APPEALS REQUIRED MPOs IN 82 AFFECTED AREAS IN 24 STATES TO SHOW AIR QUALITY CONFORMITY FOR TRANSPORTATION PROJECTS TO A 1997 AIR QUALITY STANDARD
 - THE FEBRUARY 2018 DC COURT VERDICT AFFECTED THE LAS VEGAS AREA
 - AIR QUALITY CONFORMITY IS REQUIRED FOR NEW PROJECTS ADDED TO RTC's REGIONAL TIP, WHICH WAS DELAYING ADDING SEVERAL MAJOR FRI 2 FUNDED PROJECTS IN CLARK COUNTY



FEDERAL UPDATE

- US DOT ISSUED VERSION 3.0 OF THEIR FEDERAL GUIDANCE FOR AUTOMATED VEHICLES
 - THE TERM 'DRIVER' DOES NOT REFER EXCLUSIVELY TO A HUMAN OPERATOR; IT NOW CAN REFER TO AN AUTOMATED SYSTEM
 - ANNOUNCES SEVERAL UPCOMING RULEMAKINGS BY USDOT AGENCIES
 - AFFIRMS USDOT SUPPORT FOR PRESERVATION OF 5.9 GHz SPECTRUM





VISIT TO COLORADO DOT AND PANASONIC MOBILITY CENTER

- RTC of SOUTHERN NEVADA AND NDOT LEADERSHIP VISITED WITH COLORADO DOT DIRECTOR AND STAFF AND TOURED PANASONIC FACILITY ON OCTOBER 4TH
- LEARNED MORE ABOUT COLORADO DOT's "ROAD X" PROGRAM
- DISCUSSED THE BENEFITS TO SAFETY AND MOBILITY FROM CONNECTED VEHICLES
- INVESTIGATING THE FEASIBILITY OF A MULTI-STATE PARTNERSHIP WITH UTAH AND COLORADO; MORE INFORMATION TO COME

- RENO-TAHOE AIRPORT REQUESTED FLYOVER RAMP BE INCLUDED IN DRAFT EIS; COULD NOT INCLUDE WITHOUT DELAYING NEPA SCHEDULE
 - WORKING TO INCLUDE SB FLYOVER RAMP IN FINAL EIS, SUBJECT TO FHWA APPROVAL



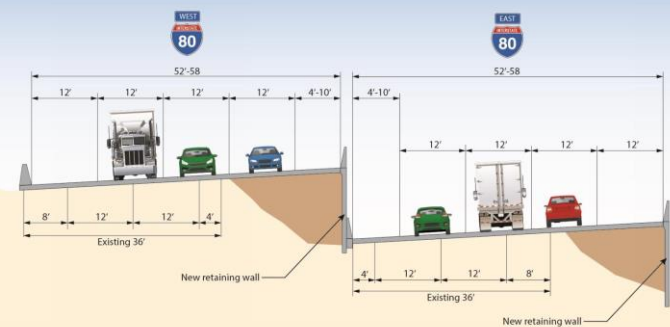
I-80 UNSOLICITED PROPOSAL

- 6-LANE WIDENING + OPERATION & MAINTENANCE FROM VISTA BLVD TO USA PARKWAY (13 MILES)
- ROUTINE MAINTENANCE FROM USA PARKWAY TO NEVADA PACIFIC PARKWAY (17 MILES)

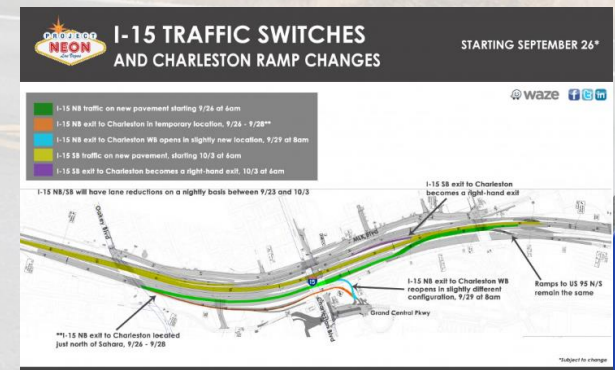
- DESERT ENGINEERING

PROJECT NEON UPDATE

- CHARLESTON BOULEVARD ON RAMP TO SOUTHBOUND I-15 OPENED ON OCTOBER 3RD
- US 95 CLOSURE CONDUCTED OVER THE WEEKEND
- MAJOR I-15 TRAFFIC SHIFT EXPECTED IN NOVEMBER; TRANSPORTATION BOARD MEETING WILL BE HELD IN LAS VEGAS ON NOVEMBER 14TH





SOUTHERN NV PROJECTS

FUEL REVENUE INDEXING (FRI 2)

- FRI 2 REVENUE MUST BE SPENT IN THE COUNTY OF ORIGIN (CLARK COUNTY)
- THERE IS NO DIVERSION OF FUNDING TO OTHER AREAS OF THE STATE AS A RESULT OF THE ADDITIONAL FRI 2 REVENUE IN SOUTHERN NEVADA
- DIRECTOR MALFABON PRESENTED CONCEPTUAL LIST TO RTC OF SOUTHERN NEVADA BOARD LAST MONTH
- TRANSPORTATION BOARD APPROVAL WILL BE REQUESTED AS THE PROJECTS ARE ADDED TO THE STIP (PRELIMINARY LIST AT THIS TIME; SUBJECT TO AVAILABLE FUNDS AND PROJECT SCHEDULES)

CLARK COUNTY 215 BELTWAY ROAD TRANSFER STATUS

- CLARK COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS APPROVED ON OCTOBER 2ND
- TRANSFERS MAINTENANCE RESPONSIBILITY FOR PORTIONS OF THE FOLLOWING NDOT ROADS
 - CHARLESTON BOULEVARD; CC215 BELTWAY TO HUALAPAI, SOUTH HALF (NORTH HALF IS CITY OF LAS VEGAS AND WILL BE TRANSFERRED TO CITY SEPARATELY)
 - SAHARA AVENUE; RAINBOW TO TAM; SOUTH HALF (NORTH HALF IS IN CITY OF LAS VEGAS AND WILL BE TRANSFERRED TO THE CITY SEPARATELY)
 - RUSSELL ROAD; POLARIS TO LV BLVD.
 - TROPICANA AVENUE; LV BLVD. TO MARYLAND PKWY.
- NDOT TAKES ON MAINTENANCE RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE 215 BELTWAY FROM STEPHANIE AVENUE TO WARM SPRINGS (PECOS TO WARM SPRINGS WIDENING WILL BE PERFORMED BY CLARK COUNTY, THEN TRANSFER TO NDOT)
- APPROXIMATELY 18 MONTHS TO TRANSFER OWNERSHIP (AFTER NDOT RIGHT-OF-WAY ESTABLISHES LEGAL DESCRIPTIONS FOR HIGHWAYS BEING TRANSFERRED)
- REQUEST TRANSPORTATION BOARD CONSENT IN NOVEMBER; MAINTENANCE RESPONSIBILITY STARTS 30 DAYS AFTER THE TRANSFER AGREEMENT IS EXECUTED.
