




EMERGENCY OPERATIONS

OVERHEAD POWER LINES WERE DAMAGED ON NEVADA DAY WEEKEND BY A WASHOE COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT HELICOPTER ESCORTING VICE PRESIDENT PENCE

EMERGENCY REPAIR OF DAMAGED POWER LINES BY NV ENERGY WILL REQUIRE FULL CLOSURE OF I-580 BETWEEN US 50 AND BOWERS MANSION ROAD ON NOVEMBER 17TH AND 18TH, 7 A.M. TO 1 P.M. EACH DAY.

DUE TO THE LOCATION OF THE POWER LINES, TRAFFIC IS UNABLE TO DETOUR AT DUCK HILL (INTERCHANGE AT EAST LAKE BOULEVARD)

FEDERAL UPDATE

- FFY 19 APPROPRIATIONS BILL FOR SURFACE TRANSPORTATION AND HOUSING IS EXPECTED BEFORE DECEMBER 7TH
- DEMOCRAT LEADERSHIP IS SUPPORTIVE OF AN INFRASTRUCTURE BILL WHEN CONGRESS CONVENES IN 2019
- CONGRESSMAN PETER DEFAZIO WILL CHAIR HOUSE TRANSPORTATION AND INFRASTRUCTURE COMMITTEE





XPRESS WEST UPDATE

- THE XPRESS WEST HIGH SPEED RAIL PROJECT WAS PURCHASED BY BRIGHTLINE
- NDOT HAS HAD PRELIMINARY DISCUSSIONS AND IS REVIEWING A PROPOSED MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WHICH LAYS OUT HOW NDOT WILL WORK WITH THE PRIVATE COMPANY TO SUPPORT THEIR PROJECT (STAFF REVIEWS OF DESIGN SUBMITTALS, etc.)



NEVADA SHARED RADIO SYSTEM UPDATE

- NDOT RECEIVED INTERIM FINANCE COMMITTEE BUDGET AUTHORITY FOR STATE FY 19 EXPENDITURES FROM THE STATE HIGHWAY FUND
- FUNDING SPLIT BETWEEN HIGHWAY FUND AND GENERAL FUND AGENCIES WAS ACCEPTABLE
- DECEMBER IFC WILL ADDRESS NON-HIGHWAY FUND REQUEST (APPROXIMATELY \$513,000)







US 50 WIDENING UPDATE

- ROY'S ROAD TO US 95A BIDS OPENED
 - GRANITE CONSTRUCTION IS APPARENT LOW BIDDER AT APPROXIMATELY \$50 MILLION
 - WIDENS US 50 TO 4 LANES TO SILVER SPRINGS
 - INCLUDES A ROUNDABOUT AT THE JUNCTION WITH US
 95A
 - INSTALLS HORSE FENCING ALONG RIGHT-OF-WAY





MT. ROSE HIGHWAY ROAD SAFETY ASSESSMENT (RSA)

- RSA WAS CONDUCTED IN JULY 2018
- DIRECTOR MALFABON RECEIVED A DRAFT REPORT BRIEFING ON OCTOBER 2ND AND DIRECTED NDOT STAFF TO PROCEEDING WITH EARLY ACTION ITEMS ASSOCIATED WITH SIGNING AND LIGHTING CHANGES; MAJOR IMPROVEMENTS WILL BE ADDED TO THE STIP
- NDOT CONDUCTED AN INITIAL REVIEW MEETING WITH MT. ROSE HIGHWAY STAKEHOLDERS TO PRESENT INITIAL FINDINGS ON OCTOBER 29, 2018
- A COMMUNITY MEETING TO PRESENT THE RSA FINDINGS IS SCHEDULED FOR EARLY DECEMBER 2018












GARNET INTERCHANGE RIBBON CUTTING
