Nevada Administrative Code 484D – Information Item Over-Dimensional Vehicle Permits Proposed Regulation Amendments

Chapter 484D: Equipment and Size, Weight and Load of Vehicles

- The State of Nevada Legislature delegates rulemaking authority to many agencies throughout the State (NRS 645C.210 (2) (a)).
- NDOT is defined as such an agency. In accordance with NRS 233B.031, and the Board may consider adoption of regulations or amendments to existing regulations.
- The State of Nevada Administrative Rulemaking Manual defines this process and if regulations and amendments are proposed when a need is defined by stakeholders within or external to an agency.





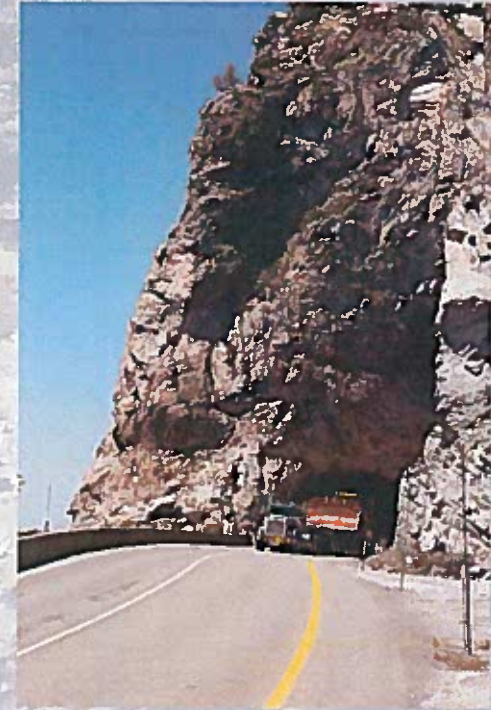
Over-Dimensional Vehicle Stakeholders and Proposed Amendments

Stakeholders

- AASHTO; WASHTO; Nevada Trucking Association, includes their Board Members, Paul DeLong Heavy Haul (Southern Nevada, Las Vegas) and Todd Anderson Lakeside Specialized Transportation (Northern Nevada, Verdi); and NDOT staff members.

Summary Proposed Key Amendments

- **Sections 1 & 2:** Updates: hours, online permitting system, deposits, and super loads.
- **Section 3:** Allow for permits to be displayed on a mobile device.
- **Section 4:** Department may require surveys (20W x 18H).
- **Section 5:** Single trip permit increased to 14-wide & "gamblers curfew" hours added
 - 2 p.m. and 10 p.m. on the portion of northbound Interstate Highway No. 15 between the boundary of California and Las Vegas (Exit 33) @ 12-wide.
 - Language referring to mechanically-steered rear axels (added by the industry, 2002).
 - For Sunday travel between the of 2 p.m. and 10 p.m. over the portion of southbound Interstate Highway No. 15 between Las Vegas (Exit 33) & CA boundary.
- **Section 6:** Allows for movement of 14-wide loads on interstates for annual permits.

Discuss proposed changes and consider impacts on small businesses

Conduct workshop/s

Draft Changes

Submit draft to LCB Counsel

★ LCB finalizes the draft and sends to originating agency

Set date for a public hearing and issue 30-Day notice

Evaluate and consider public comment. Draft informational statement.

Agency (Transportation Board) adopts amendments and submits to LCB

LCB finalizes amended regulation with the Secretary of State



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
