What is the One Nevada Transportation Plan?



The *One Nevada Transportation Plan* is our “roadmap” to meeting a shared vision.

Transportation connects all Nevadans. It is critical to people’s daily lives and the competitiveness of Nevada’s economy. Planning for Nevada’s transportation future enables transportation agencies to maximize public investments that enhance traveler safety; preserve transportation infrastructure; optimize

how Nevadans travel; transform state, regional, and local economies; foster sustainable transportation choices; and connect communities while linking Nevada to the rest of the world.

It is a plan for Nevada’s transportation needs, now and into the future. It spells out the priorities and strategies needed to maintain a safe, efficient transportation system with limited and changing funding resources. The *One Nevada Transportation Plan* supports a transparent, value-based process for determining priorities. Providing a unifying framework and guidance for our state, this plan helps integrate statewide, regional, and local transportation plans state, regional, and local plans to ensure Nevada is moving in the right direction, together.

Why do we need a plan?

Changes in transportation technologies and in the way people travel, pressure to move increasing numbers of people and goods, and aging infrastructure all put increased demands on our limited resources, including funding. Demand, along with expectations, for mobility and connectivity options by air, bicycle, foot, transit, rail, vehicle and emerging technologies continue to increase. Prioritizing these needs statewide, and allocating funds wisely, is critical.

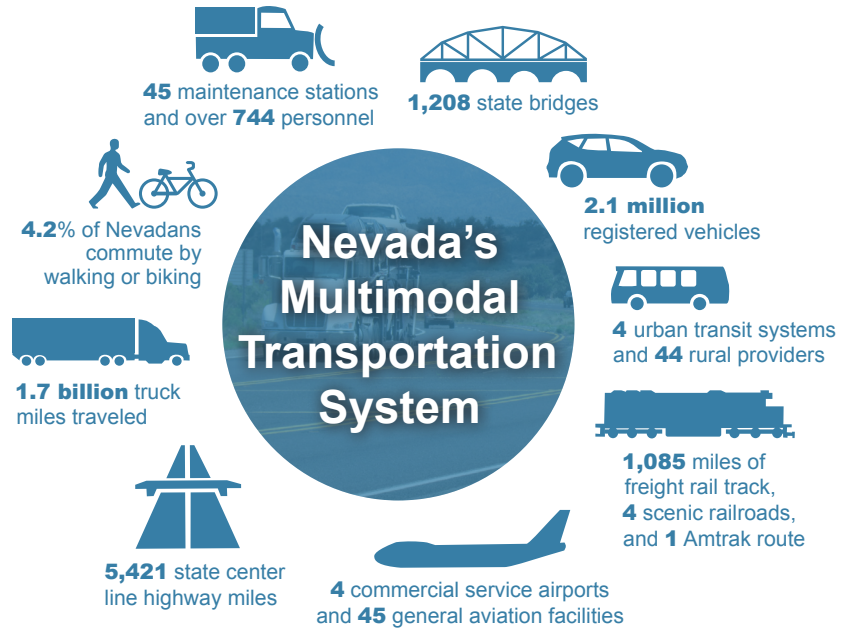

Facts about Nevada:

- Between 2010 and 2017 Nevada's total population grew by nearly 300,000 new residents (an 11% increase) ranking **Nevada as the sixth fastest growing state in the country.**
- More than one million new residents are expected to call Nevada "home" by the year 2040.
- More than 56 million people visited the state in 2017 (that's like the entire population of Texas visiting Nevada twice).
- Nevada's economy continues to diversify.
