The Nevada Department of Transportation keeps the official record of all proceedings of the meeting. In order to maintain a complete and accurate record, copies of documents used during a presentation must be submitted to the Recording Secretary.

The Nevada Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Board appreciates the time citizens devote to be involved in this important process.

Public comment is limited to 5 minutes per person.

Agenda items may be taken out of the order presented on the agenda at the discretion of the chairperson. The Board may combine two or more agenda items for consideration. The Board may remove an item from the agenda or delay discussion relating to an agenda item at any time. The Board may make reasonable restrictions on time, place, and manner but will not restrict the comments based upon viewpoint.

- 5. Proposed Standard Rumble Stripe Design (for possible action)** Ken Mammen, Safety Engineering
The NDOT is proposing a new rumble stripe design that is more compatible with bicyclists and motorcyclists. An overview of the standard will be presented. Action may be taken to provide an advisory recommendation to the NDOT Director endorsing this new standard.
- 6. Update on combining the Nevada Bicycle and Pedestrian Summit**
The Nevada Bicycle and Pedestrian Summit is an annual meeting focused on issues affecting bicyclists and pedestrians. Discussion will take place on the opportunity of combining the Nevada Bicycle and Pedestrian Summit with another conference or summit initiative in 2019
- 7. Overview of the Nevada Bicycle and Pedestrian Award Program** *Bill Story*
The State Bicycle and Pedestrian Award program recognizes exemplary people, agencies, and organizations that are making a significant difference in bicycling and pedestrian programs, facilities, safety, or promotion in Nevada. These are awarded by the Board at the annual Bicycle and Pedestrian Summit.
- 8. Discussion and update of emerging technologies related to micro-Mobility** *Ron Floth*
Nevada is seeing an increase in new personal traveling conveyances. A discussion and update will take place on issues, concerns, and opportunities.
- 9. Legislative Update** *Bill Story*
An update will be provided concerning known, proposed legislation pertaining to bicyclists and pedestrians for the 2019 Session.
- 10. Reports from the Bicycle and Pedestrian Programs Statewide**
An update of projects and initiatives being worked on by the NDOT and the two large Metropolitan Planning Areas will be given.

Reports will be provided from NBPAB members on activities, initiatives or issues specific to their sectors occurring since the last meeting on March 21st, 2019.
