 - Inform prioritization process for planning documents and resource allocations

Improve consistency between various PM reporting requirements

PROPOSED CHANGES - MINOR

- PM 4 Streamline Agreement Process
 - Current Measure: Percentage Agreements processed within 30 days
 - Current Status (2019) 97%
 - Proposed Measure: Percentage Agreements processed within 20 days
 - Target remains at 90%
- PM 6 Reduce and Maintain Traffic Congestion Name change to "Improve Reliability and Reduce Delay"
- PM 12 Reduce Fatal and Serious Injury Crashes
 Simplify measure from projected to historical 5 year average



PROPOSED CHANGES - SIGNIFICANT

PM8 - Maintain State Highway Pavement

Measure - Percent of state-maintained roadways in fair or better condition

Category 1	95 %	Category 1	98.4%	Category 1	95 %
Category 2	95 %	Category 2	87.7 %	Category 2	90%

PAVEMENT PRESERVATION OPTIONS




FIGURE E1. Future State-maintained Roadway Network Funding Options



PROPOSED CHANGES - SIGNIFICANT

PM 14 - Maintain State Bridges

- <u>Current Measure</u>: Number of structurally deficient (SD) or functionally obsolete (FO) bridges replaced or rehabilitated.
- Current Target: One or more
- Proposed Measure: Percentage of bridge inventory considered to be in "Good" and "Poor" condition.
- Proposed Targets: >35% Good and < 7% Poor</p>



PROPOSED CHANGES - SIGNIFICANT

NEW PM- Reduce Greenhouse Gas (GHG) emissions

- Proposed Measure: Annual GHG emissions from Transportation Sector in Nevada
- Proposed Target: Reduction based on annual inventory report (DCNR/NDEP)



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
