


Annual Work Program Adjustments due to COVID-19 Revenue Impacts

PROJECTED HIGHWAY FUND REVENUE

Traffic Count Decreases from Same Time Last Year



COVID-19 related travel restrictions have led to a strong, but temporary decline in vehicle travel.

Projected revenue decline: SFY 2020: \$63 M SFY 2021: \$80 M Total: \$143 M



- NDOT first looked internally estimated reduction in agency operational spending of ~ \$5 M in SFY 2020 and \$10 M in 2021
- Reduce new commitments & leverage federal funds
 - Projects awarded will continue
 - Federal funded projects will continue
 - Projects already delayed/cancelled \$23.5 M
 - State funded projects not yet awarded were considered for cancellation or delay



Three Options have been developed to reduce future spending in consideration of highway fund revenue declines:

- Option 1 Delay two reconstruction projects in two counties \$44.3M (\$72.8 M)
- Option 2 Delay nine maintenance/preservation projects in seven counties - \$34.9 M (\$63.4 M)
- Option 3 Continue current planned projects, more significant reduction in FY 2021 (\$28.5 M)



Additional Spending Reduction - Option 1

Delay the following projects:

Project	Cost
US 50/US 95, White Pine County, Downtown Ely Reconstruction	\$29,800,000
I 80, Elko County, from West Elko interchange (MP EL 20.26) to Mile Post EL 26.72, 3R	\$14,500,000
Total	\$44,300,000

Total reductions = \$72,800,000

Continue with current planned projects and adjust FY 2021 Annual Work Program for remaining estimated revenue reduction

Total reductions = \$28,500,000



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- Option 2 Delay nine maintenance/preservation projects in seven counties -\$34.9 M (\$63.4 M)
- Option 3 Continue current planned projects, more significant reduction in FY 2021 (\$28.5 M)
