3. PUBLIC COMMENT AND CITIZENS PARTICIPATION:

No action may be taken on any matter discussed under this item that is not listed on this Agenda, although the NBPAB can direct that such items be placed on a future agenda.

At this time, any citizen in the audience may address the NBPAB on any matter. No vote can be taken on a matter not listed on the posted agenda; however, the NBPAB can direct that the matter be placed on a future agenda.

Each citizen must be recognized by the Chairperson. The citizen is then to approach the microphone to state his or her name, and to spell the last name for the record. The Chairperson may limit remarks if such remarks are disruptive to the meeting or not within the NBPAB's jurisdiction.

The Nevada Department of Transportation keeps the official record of all proceedings of the meeting. To maintain a complete and accurate record, copies of documents used during a presentation must be submitted to the Recording Secretary.

The Nevada Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Board appreciates the time citizens devote to be involved in this important process.

Public comment is limited to 5 minutes per person.

Agenda items may be taken out of the order presented on the agenda at the discretion of the Chairperson. The Board may combine two or more agenda items for consideration. The Board may remove an item from the agenda or delay discussion relating to an agenda item at any time. The Board may make reasonable restrictions on time, place, and manner but will not restrict the comments based upon viewpoint.

4. Approval of the September 17th, 2020 and January 21st minutes (for possible action)

Action may be taken to approve the September 17th, 2020 and January 21st meeting minutes.

5. Review of "Share the Road" License Plates and Grant Applications *Albert Jacquez* (for possible action)

The NBPAB developed a "Share the Road" specialty license plate to provide additional funding for local bicycle and pedestrian initiatives throughout the state. Funds are made available through a competitive grant process administered by the NDOT. All proposed projects must not exceed more than \$2,000.00 and be focused on safety education concerning one or more of the following criteria:

- Initiation, promotion, and support of bicycle and pedestrian safety and education programs in Nevada
- Financial support of the planning and construction of bicycle and pedestrian facilities in Nevada
- Grants for community-based bicycle and pedestrian projects and programs in Nevada
- Bicycle and pedestrian safety outreach

A review of all applications received will be given.

7. Tahoe Transportation Initiatives TTD representative

8. 81st Legislative Session Update, Alan Bohemier,

NDOT Active Transportation Manager (for possible action) An update will be provided on the introduction of any proposed legislation related to bicycling or walking. This includes Senate Bill (SB) 183 that will be introduced on March 17th.

Action may be taken to provide advisement to appropriate agencies regarding these proposed changes to State law.



9. Reports from the Bicycle and Pedestrian Programs Statewide An update of projects and initiatives being worked on by the NDOT and the

Washoe County and Clark County Metropolitan Planning Areas will be given.
