FALL 2021 PROJECT UPDATE

## DESCRIPTION

US 395 is the major connection between Reno/ Sparks and Golden Valley, Lemmon Valley, and Cold Springs areas. This route serves as the main connection to northeastern California. To enhance traffic safety and mobility in this ever-growing corridor, NDOT will rehabilitate the existing roadway, add capacity, and improve travel efficiency along this corridor. This two-phased project will support planned land uses and economic development.

This phase will consist of the addition of a lane in both the southbound and northbound directions. \*The reconfiguration of the Lemmon Dr. interchange into a diverging diamond interchange (DDI) is anticipated to begin in November 2021 with the Regional Transportation Commission of Washoe County's (RTC) Lemmon Drive Project.

Phase 2 construction anticipated to start in 2026
