NDOT's I-15 express lane project will add two express lanes in each direction of I-15 alongside the Strip. Separated from regular travel lanes by 'candlestick' delineators, through traffic can make the five-plus mile journey past the resort corridor in the express lanes; reducing weaving, merging and congestion.

While the project is nearly complete, many have already noticed improvements, including Las Vegas Review-Journal transportation columnist Adrienne Packer.

"Express lanes on Interstate 15 allow motorists to zip down to the Las Vegas Beltway from Sahara Avenue without dealing with merging drivers," she wrote.



Lynette McCutcheon and her mother were driving north of Reno recently when their car tire went flat. Without being able to verify their motorist assistance program membership, they were left helpless until NDOT Resident Engineer Shane Cocking pulled up.
