NOTE: During a reduced inspection schedule, the Operator shall inspect the site <u>at least once every 30 days</u> and <u>within 24 hours of the end of each storm event of 0.25 inch or greater during a 24 hour period.</u> The reduced schedule shall be documented in the SWPPP and the beginning and ending dates of the period noted on this form
