The Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT) is in the process of identifying and evaluating future safety improvements for approximately 11 miles of US 50 from the Nevada/California state line to the junction of SR 28. NDOT would like feedback from the community concerning the concepts to enhance safety in this corridor.

Proposed future safety improvements within the corridor include:

- Roadway resurfacing/restriping
- Lane reconfiguration including bicycle lanes
- Roundabouts
- Bicycle and pedestrian enhancements along the roadway
- Designated turn lanes, acceleration/deceleration lanes, and designated turnout locations for slow moving vehicles

The concepts presented as part of this study may be adopted during a subsequent environmental review process.

This meeting is being held in an open house format from 4 to 7 p.m. Project representatives will give a brief presentation beginning at 5:30 p.m. followed by a short question and answer period from the audience. Project representatives will be available to answer questions before and after the presentation. During this meeting, and through Friday, June 16, 2017, your comments are welcome regarding this project.
