FEDERAL UPDATE

- SENATE & HOUSE TO RECONCILE USDOT BUDGET FOR SURFACE TRANSPORTATION & TRANSIT
- BUDGET CEILING AND FUNDING OF “THE WALL” WILL BE ISSUES
- INFRASTRUCTURE BILL LIKELY IN 2018; TIED TO TAX REFORM
- CONTINUING RESOLUTION (SHORT TERM EXTENSION) LIKELY FOR BEGINNING OF FFY 18 (STARTING OCTOBER 1ST)



FEDERAL UPDATE

- HOUSE PASSED THE “SELF DRIVE ACT”, THE PROPOSED FEDERAL POLICY FOR SELF-DRIVING CARS; SENATE EXPECTED TO DO THE SAME
- FY 17 TIGER GRANT NOTICE RELEASED, \$500 MILLION AVAILABLE; APPLICATIONS DUE OCTOBER 16TH
- FORMER IOWA DOT SECRETARY PAUL TROMBINO III NOMINATED FOR FHWA ADMINISTRATOR

- I-15 GARNET INTERCHANGE DESIGN-BUILD
 - NDOT WILL MEET WITH REPUBLIC SERVICES TO DISCUSS CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS AT INTERCHANGE FOR SANITATION TRUCK OPERATIONS AT LANDFILL
- I-15 TROPICANA INTERCHANGE; HACIENDA AND HARMON HOV RAMPS ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE
 - CA GROUP SELECTED; OCTOBER CONTRACT APPROVAL
- I-15 NORTH AT CC 215 BELTWAY, SYSTEM TO SYSTEM INTERCHANGE FINAL DESIGN
 - ATKINS SELECTED; OCTOBER CONTRACT APPROVAL

CONSULTANT PROCUREMENT

- NDOT SEEKS TO FIND THE BEST, MOST QUALIFIED FIRM ON A PROJECT BY PROJECT BASIS
- NDOT SELECTION PROCESS IS CONSISTENTLY APPLIED TO ALL RFPs; OVERSIGHT BY ADMIN. SERVICES
- FHWA HAS APPROVED NDOT CONSULTANT SELECTION PROCEDURES
- FHWA REVIEW RECENTLY EVALUATED 9 FEDERALLY FUNDED RFPs, CONFIRMED NDOT CONFORMANCE WITH FEDERAL REGULATIONS



CONSULTANT PROCUREMENT

- REVIEW SELECTION CRITERIA AND POINTS ASSIGNED FOR EACH RFP TO ENSURE THEY ARE APPROPRIATE
- SELECTION CRITERIA INCLUDE PROJECT TEAM, PROJECT APPROACH, AVAILABILITY AND CAPACITY, PAST PERFORMANCE, REGIONAL KNOWLEDGE, AND MINORITY CONTRACTING (DBE) IF APPLICABLE
- AVOID INFLUENCING TEAMING ARRANGEMENTS
 - BUSINESS DECISION FOR COMPETING CONSULTING FIRMS



CONSULTANT PROCUREMENT RECOMMENDATIONS

- CONSIDER ALL QUALIFIED AND AVAILABLE CONSULTANTS ON RFP PROCUREMENTS
 - ELIMINATE UNREALISTIC RFP REQUIREMENTS THAT MAY BE TOO RESTRICTIVE
 - DRAFT RFP TO ENCOURAGE PARTICIPATION FROM ALL AVAILABLE QUALIFIED FIRMS
- FAIR AND IMPARTIAL REVIEW OF PROPOSALS
 - EVALUATION COMMITTEE MEMBERS CAREFULLY EVALUATE EACH PROPOSAL ACCORDING TO THE PUBLISHED CRITERIA
 - COMMITTEE MEMBERS ARE AWARE OF THEIR OBLIGATION TO SELECT THE MOST QUALIFIED FIRM FOR THE SPECIFIC PROJECT
 - FIRMS ARE INVITED TO A DEBRIEF, BUT SOME DO NOT ACCEPT

- FERRIS INVESTMENTS TENTATIVE SETTLEMENT AT \$1.9 M SUBJECT TO BOE APPROVAL (PROJECT NEON; SEPTEMBER BOE)
- RANCH PROPERTIES SETTLEMENT \$2.2 M (PROJECT NEON; OCTOBER BOE TENTATIVE)
- REICH PROPERTY TENTATIVE SETTLEMENT \$1.7 M (PROJECT NEON; OCTOBER BOE TENTATIVE)
